

## ABOUT THE M25-804 STUDY

This study is open to men and women who are between the ages of 50 and 90 years old that are known to have increased risk of, showing signs of, or have been diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease (AD). Additional criteria will apply.

Various screening assessments will be performed to determine if you are eligible for this study. If you qualify, and decide to take part in this study, you will be randomly assigned (by chance) to receive either the investigational study drug or placebo. The placebo looks the same as the investigational study drug but is not expected to have any effects on the body. Neither you nor the study doctor and staff will know if you are assigned to receive the investigational study drug or placebo.

Study participants must attend all visits and complete required procedures, which include receiving the study drug or placebo, undergoing clinical assessments, lab work, questionnaires and undergoing imaging tests like MRI and PET scans.

Researchers with the M25-804 study are evaluating an investigational drug for Alzheimer's disease. The findings from this research study will help increase understanding of the investigational drug and whether it may help people with Alzheimer's disease.

## M25-804 STUDY OVERVIEW

This clinical research study includes a Screening period, Double-blind period, and Follow-up period. Participants that complete treatment in the double-blind period will have the option to participate in the Extension period.

If you complete the Screening period, are determined eligible and decide to enroll in the research study, your participation in this Double-blind period will last up to 28 weeks and the Follow-up period will last 12 weeks. Participation in the optional Extension period will last approximately 1 year.

While you're enrolled in this research study, all study-related visits, tests, and study drugs will be provided at no cost. You do not need health insurance to participate. You may be reimbursed for your travel expenses.

## WHAT IS A CLINICAL TRIAL?

A clinical trial is a research study done with people to test things like new/ investigational drugs, medical devices, and/or procedures. Volunteers take part under the close supervision of doctors, staff and researchers, and their health is closely watched to see how well the drug, device or procedure works and to discover any side effects before the product becomes widely available.
