



# Can we slow Alzheimer's down?



**The ABATE research study is seeking participants to help find a potential treatment that could improve the way we treat Alzheimer's**

ABATE is a clinical study evaluating a potential treatment called ACI-24.060 in people with mild cognitive impairment.

If you are between 50 and 85 years old and have started to have problems with memory and thinking, you may be able to help us find a new way to slow Alzheimer's down.

ACI-24.060 is an active immunotherapy that stimulates your body's natural immunity to make antibodies against amyloid-beta (A $\beta$ ), a protein that plays an important role in cognitive decline in Alzheimer's disease. Removing A $\beta$  is known to slow decline in memory loss and other cognitive function.
